Aquatic Safety Classes

Lifeguard Training

Learn the skills you need to prevent and respond to emergencies in and around the water. This American Red Cross class teaches professionalism, first aid, rescue skills, and CPR. The class meets state-mandated guidelines for lifeguards and is required for employment by many agencies. Successful participation in all three class sessions is required in order to complete the course. **Prerequisite:** 15 years old by the first day of class; 300-yard continuous swim; and 20-yard swim with a 10-lb. object. **Fee:** \$174 (\$196 NR) (plus a \$60 book and material fee payable on the first day of the course)

Water Safety Instructor

Successful completion of this course will certify you to teach all levels of American Red Cross progressive swimming courses. 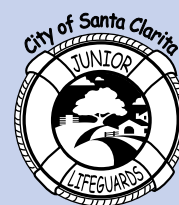
