PROPOSED SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT

The City of Santa Clarita (City) proposes to make the following amendment to its Action Plan:

- Combine the Sidewalk Access Curb Cuts Program, funded at \$25,000, and the ADA Access Ramp Construction Program, funded at \$250,000, into one program.

BACKGROUND

In the 2015-16 Annual Action Plan, the City funded two different programs to provide greater disabled access around the City by retrofitting the sidewalks at corners with concrete ramps built to Americans with Disability Act standards and make some related improvements to adjacent sidewalks. Initially, these programs had differences in the scope of work which made it necessary to divide the work into two projects.

As the project description was more fully refined and other funds became available for non-ramp related parts of the Sidewalk Access Curb Cuts Project, it became possible to limit the CDBG funds to ramp construction only in both programs. Combining the programs will reduce redundancy in contracting, increase economies of scale, and increase organizational efficiency.

Notice is hereby given that the City of Santa Clarita will be inviting public comment and review of the City's Substantial Amendment to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) 2015-16 Annual Action Plan (AAP). The 30-day review and comment period will be from October 25, 2015 to November 25, 2015.

The Substantial Amendment, required by HUD, describes changes to the AAP. The AAP describes the use of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding for the 2015-2016 program year; the projects, programs, and actions the City will take to benefit persons with incomes at or below 80% of L.A. County's median income level.
